Scope

- measurement techniques for micro- and nano-fields

Presentations, call for papers

Oral presentations will be held by invited lecturers. Offers of poster contributions are invited on the above scope. Poster contributions (70cm width x100cm height) will be presented with 5 minutes oral introduction (max. 5 ppt slides). Discussion will be held in front of the poster. LCD projector with computer will be available.

The official language is English.

Symposium volume will be published in the form of Abstracts (max.2 pages of A/4 text, incl. tables and figures). One copy will be provided for each participant.
